- Parking: please park in your driveway only. RV's and trailers of any kind are not permitted.
- Boat dock: Sorry, but we don't have space for overnight docking for guests. Brief tie-ups are permitted at the end of the covered dock.
- Pets: Westwood Village rules prohibit pets in rentals.
- Noise: Understand that living units are close together and often share common walls; please respect your neighbors' expectations of peace and quiet. Quiet time is 9 PM to 9 AM.

- **No liability** is assumed by Westwood Village so enjoy recreational amenities at your own risk; **No lifeguards** are posted; swim within the designated area of the lake.
- Pool Rules: Children under 12 must be with an adult; no glass containers; closes at 10 PM.
- Aerial fireworks are illegal in the City of Sandpoint. They create an immense fire danger.
- Familiarize yourself with emergency exits in your unit and the location of the fire extinguishers.
- Open fires are permitted only in an enclosed metal fire receptacle (if provided with your unit) and in the fire ring in the sand near the lake swim area. (NOTE: when fire danger is high in the area, all fires are strictly prohibited by law.)
- Garbage and recycling is collected Tuesday mornings- please use large bags and the green recycling bin and place in view at the street edge.
- Small boat launch (kayaks, canoes, paddleboards): As you approach the shore turn right. Just past (west) of the marina area is a low bank stretch where entering the water is easier. It's rocky, though- wear protective shoes.
